  - Check the website for upcoming events and meeting dates.
  - Frost delays will be announced to participating players via Golf Genius email.
- **Birdies**
  - League play birdies will be calculated and paid out in June and December through Golf Genius.
- **Ringers**
  - Your best score for both net and gross on each hole will be calculated through Golf Genius and awarded in June and December.
- **Hole In One Insurance - optional**
  - Once a “hole in one” has been achieved, a new “hole in one” pot will start over. Please check the website to see if you have paid before paying again.
- **Local Club State Medallion Tournament** <https://www.azgolf.org/womens-tournament-regulations-event-descriptions/>
  - Competition will be open to AGA members on the club member’s Play Day and will consist of two best gross and two best 18-hole rounds for 18-hole clubs out of four designated rounds. Players need not participate in all four rounds to be eligible. Determining the winner on the basis of the best two rounds out of four is intended to give players the maximum opportunity to produce two good scores, not to eliminate those players who cannot play all four rounds. The AGA recommends that all four rounds be played on the same course. All 18-hole rounds should be posted as “T” scores as determined by the local Handicap Committee in consultation with the Committee in charge of the competition if it meets The USGA Handicap System’s definition of Tournament Score.
- **SDWGA – Southern District Women’s Golf Association -** [www.sdwga.com](http://www.sdwga.com)
  - This organization plans and conducts golf events for its members and assists member clubs upon request. SDWGA sponsors three district-wide partner tournaments. Schedule and entry forms for these events are available online at [www.sdwga.com](http://www.sdwga.com)
  - Southern District sponsors two tournaments run by the local SDWGA Representative at each member club.
    - **Telegraph:** This is a one-day flighted net tournament among Southern District members of record on the day of the tournament.
    - **Del Sud (Eclectic):** This is a two-day eclectic net ringer tournament.
  - Yearly dues are \$10 per person (Jan-Dec) payable with your yearly membership dues. Of the \$10 dues, 50% is retained by SILGA for payouts in the 2 local tournaments and the other 50% goes to SDWGA.
